Notice of the confirmation by An Coimisiún Pleanála of a Compulsory Purchase Order pursuant to Section 76 of, and the Third Schedule to, the Housing Act, 1966, as extended by Section 10 of the Local Government (No. 2) Act, 1960 (as substituted by Section 86 of the Housing Act, 1966), as respects all of the land to which the Compulsory Purchase Order relates to be published in accordance with Section 78(1) of the Housing Act, 1966, as amended and extended by the Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2023 and the Roads Acts, 1993 to 2023.

## COMPULSORY ACQUISITION OF LAND

### MEATH COUNTY COUNCIL N2 SLANE BYPASS AND PUBLIC REALM ENHANCEMENT SCHEME COMPULSORY PURCHASE (No. 1) ORDER, 2023

An Coimisiún Pleanála has, on the 27th day of June 2025, made a Confirmation Order confirming the above-named Compulsory Purchase Order in respect of the land described in Parts I & II of the Modified Schedule as submitted to the Oral Hearing on the 3rd day of April 2025 and extinguishment of Public and Private Rights of Way described in Part III & IV and acquisition of Easements described in Part V of the said Schedule.

The said Order, as so confirmed, authorises Meath County Council to acquire the said Lands and Easements compulsorily. It will become operative three weeks from the date of the publication of this notice.

The said Order also authorises the Local Authority to extinguish the Public Rights of Way described in Part III of the Schedule thereto, and to extinguish the Private Right of Way described in Part IV of the Schedule thereto.

From **23<sup>rd</sup> July 2025 to 17<sup>th</sup> October 2025** Monday to Friday (except Public Holidays) between the hours of 9.00am and 1.00pm and 2.00pm and 5.00pm.

An application for judicial review of the decision of An Coimisiún Pleanála under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No.15 of 1986) may be made to the High Court within eight weeks of the date of publication of this notice in accordance with Section 50 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 as amended and extended, the Court-

- (a) May by interim Order suspend the operation of the Compulsory Purchase Order as so confirmed either generally or in so far only as it affects any property of the applicant until the final determination of the proceedings.
- (b) If satisfied upon the hearing of the application that the Compulsory Purchase Order as so confirmed is not within the powers of the Housing Act, 1966 as extended by Section 10 of the Local Government (No. 2) Act, 1960 (as substituted by Section 86 of the Housing Act 1966), as so extended and amended, not having been complied with, may quash the Order as so confirmed either generally or in so far only as it affects any property of the applicant.

#### SCHEDULE PART I and PART II

The land to which this Confirmation Order relates as set out in Part I and Part II of the CPO Schedule is Lands in the Electoral Divisions of (i) Painestown and (ii) Slane and passing through the townlands of (i) Johnstown, (ii) Slane, (iii) Cullen, (iv) Fennor, (v) Slanecastle Demesne and (vi) Cashel, all in the County of Meath as identified in the Schedule to the CPO and on the CPO map both of which are available for inspection on the Council's dedicated Slane Bypass Website [www.n2slanebypass.ie](http://www.n2slanebypass.ie) or in the Council Offices as set out above.
